Jefferson Awards honor ordinary people who, through public service, do extraordinary things for other people, their community, their nation, or the environment.

Charlie is the founder of "adopting a park" in his town of Colonia and plants trees, and has a fall "clean up" with the community for 18 years. Charlie coached basketball and football from 1959 to 2002. Charlie distributes food, helps with housing and paying bills through the St. Vincent de Paul Society with whom he is a member. He feeds men at the Salvation Army in Perth Amboy, NJ. Charlie picks up used furniture, clothing, house wares, etc. and delivers to the Emmaus House in Perth Amboy. He has also run a coin drive for 25 years for the mentally handicapped, five years collecting for the Alzheimer fund and collecting socks, games, books, for the vets in Menlo Park, NJ. He is a past grand knight of the Knights of Columbus, and helps organize the township of Woodbridge's St. Patrick's Day parade for 34 years now. Charlie has diabetes and some days it is hard for him, but he never says no!
