THE CHORE HANDYMAN SERVICE VOLUNTEERS

Lending a helping hand! The Chore Handyman Service of the Bergen County Volunteer Center, a venue for retired persons to provide meaningful service to others established in 1977, provides crews of volunteers who perform low and no-cost home repairs to keep seniors safe in their homes.



Chore volunteers provide service without charge; the client's only responsibility is to provide the materials necessary to complete the repair. Volunteers install grab bars and railings, smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, repair leaky faucets, replace broken door and window locks, install weather-stripping and fix broken lamps and switches.

The Chore program has received both local and national acclaim for its success and beneficial impact on the community. New Jersey Magazine recognized the work of the Chore Handyman Service, honoring one of the volunteers with its "Seeds of Hope" award, given to exemplary charitable organizations and residents of New Jersey.
