Ms. Schleicher began her early public service with the Denville PTA and League of Women Voters. She also served ten years on the Denville Planning Board where she became active in the N.J. Association of Planning Boards and Zoning Boards and served as president. Simultaneously, Ms. Schleicher began working for the Morris County Planning and Development Agency's Transportation Management Division. In 1986, Ms. Schleicher helped form a non-profit alliance group for business and government transportation called "McRides."

For the last seven years Ms. Schleicher served as president of Protect Our Wetlands, Water & Woods. During this time, Ms. Schleicher was a member of the Morris County Open Space Trust Fund Committee, moving on to become a Morris County Park Commissioner, and then president of the organization in 2008. In parallel with those commitments, Ms. Schleicher was appointed to the Denville Township Open Space Committee, becoming president of that committee in January, 2008.
